Discussion/Interpretation:

The 2005 Legislation changed statutory requirements related to cross reporting of child abuse reports between the two agencies, in order to better identify priority reports. This rule change is based on SB94. This rule change is necessary in order to be consistent with statute.

This is a draft rule that is available for comment until June 1, 2006.

Training/Communication Plan: An email has gone to managers of Child Welfare describing all changes. The CAF Legislative Video Conference and Legislative Road Show, with Timothy Travis, are two trainings that have already occurred covering this revision. In addition, there will be presentations at the SDA managers (1/4/06), the CW Program managers (1/11/06), Supervisor’s quarterlies (1/17/-06 – 1/20/06), and CPS Quartiles (end of January – beginning of February) communicating this revised rule.
