OAR 413-040-0006 (3)(a)(B) is being amended to clarify the Department's responsibility to determine child safety.

OAR 413-040-0009 is being amended to clarify the Department's policy regarding the return of a child to a parent or legal guardian that may or may not reside in a home.

OAR 413-040-0010 is being amended to comply with federal requirements of a case plan, specifying the inclusion of the child's health information (310H), educational services (310E), and progress in implementing the concurrent plan as a part of the case plan; and specifying the statutory requirement to include a record of the child's visits with parents and siblings (310V).

OAR 413-040-0017 is being amended to describe responsibilities of the Department when returning a child to a parent who is residing in a residential treatment facility, an alcohol and drug free housing program, or a residential domestic violence program.

OAR 413-040-024 is being amended to describe the responsibilities of the Department to develop an ongoing safety plan prior to returning a child to a parent who is residing in a residential treatment facility, an alcohol and drug free housing program, or a residential domestic violence program.

Training/Communication Plan: Draft revisions are being sent to all staff through this Policy Transmittal. Once the rules are final, training will be presented to all child welfare supervisors at scheduled state quarterly meetings.
