

These rules, OAR 413-090-0100 through 413-090-0210 are being amended to clarify the purpose and criteria for personal care services provided by a foster parent, relative caregiver, or other individual who has been determined a qualified provider, to an eligible child or young adult living with a foster parent or relative caregiver. I-E.5.1.2 is further including Exhibit 1 – Levels of Personal Care, which describes the criteria for the determination of a level of personal care services.

Implementation/Transition Instructions: These changes are effective immediately. Those responsible for the preparation of referrals for a CANS screening or a Personal Care Nurse Assessment must follow these rules. When a supervision plan is requested by a foster parent or relative caregiver the child’s caseworker must develop a supervision plan within the timelines and including the contents outlined in these rules.

Training/Communication Plan: Child Welfare Program Managers will be informed of these changes by email.

Local/Branch Action Required: Ensure that referrals for a CANS screening or, when indicated, a Personal Care Nurse Assessment are completed as indicated.

Central Office Action Required: Provide technical assistance to field personnel. The foster care coordinators in the Foster Care Program are available to answer questions.
