Message: In June, the SEU (separate economic unit) HH Type code on the FS mainframe was changed to SFG (separate filing group) to reflect current policy language. This month, we are continuing to update the system by eliminating codes that are not useful. These codes do not affect the FS benefit calculation. Instead, they repeat information available elsewhere on FSMIS (e.g., OAA), or track information that is no longer needed (e.g., case-managed households, relocated hurricane victims).

FSMIS has been updated to remove these obsolete or redundant codes from both the screen and the Help window: BP, BRD, CAM, EX, GRL, HCP, IRL, IRT, LDG, OAA, OHP, SCH, SVC, TNG, UN, UST, WCB. The intent of this change is to prevent the staff work of entering unnecessary coding. This was an automated change and requires no action from the field.
