On December 13, 2011, a notice was sent in error to all State Family Pre-SSI/SSDI (SFPSS) recipients. The notice ([click here](#) to see redacted example attached) states that SFPSS clients' grant amounts will increase on January 1, 2012, and that SNAP benefits may decrease or stop as a result of the SFPSS grant increase. Once again, this notice was sent in error and should be disregarded. SFPSS grant amounts will not increase on January 1, 2012.

Central office will send a letter to all affected SFPSS clients ASAP, informing them that the notice was sent in error and that it should be disregarded.
