Sherman County PacificSource members moving to Eastern Oregon CCO Oct. 1

A notice was mailed on September 17 to PacificSource members in Sherman County letting them know they will move to Eastern Oregon Coordinated Care Organization October 1, 2012.

Curry County fee-for-service (FFS) clients who are enrolled in a Mental Health Organization (MHO) will be moving to AllCare CCOE for mental health Oct. 1, 2012.

Most of these members will be moving to AllCare CCOB for coordinated physical and mental health on Nov. 1, 2012.

A notice was mailed September 20 to Curry County FFS clients who are enrolled in an MHO for their mental health. These clients will be moving from their MHO to AllCare CCOE for their mental health care on October 1, 2012. Most of these same clients will

be moving from FFS to AllCare CCOB for their physical health care on November 1, 2012.

Tillamook County FFS clients who are enrolled in an MHO are moving to Columbia Pacific CCOE for mental health Oct. 1, 2012.

Most of these members will be moving to Columbia Pacific CCOB for coordinated physical and mental health Nov. 1, 2012.

A notice was mailed September 20 to Tillamook County FFS clients who are enrolled in an MHO for their mental health. These clients will be moving from their MHO to Columbia Pacific CCOE for their mental health care on October 1, 2012. Most of these same clients will be moving from FFS to Columbia Pacific CCOB for their physical health care on November 1, 2012.

Note: *Tillamook County FFS clients enrolled in an MHO were supposed to move to Columbia Pacific CCOE for mental health care September 1, 2012. Due to system errors, these clients will now move to Columbia Pacific CCOE for their mental health care October 1, 2012.*

Important reminder: FFS/MHO enrolled clients

Many fee-for-service clients receive physical health care through an open card, but are enrolled in a Mental Health Organization for their mental health care. Many of these clients moved from their MHO to a CCOE for their mental health care September 1, 2012.

On November 1, 2012, most clients who receive FFS physical health benefits will move into a CCO. If they receive mental health care through a CCO, they will move into that same CCO for their physical health care. If they receive both physical and mental health care through FFS, they will be auto-assigned to an appropriate CCO.
