**Action Required:** Review of new draft SE48-TCM CPAs for accuracy and then submit those CPAs to the eXPRS system for activation. These new CPAs correspond to the implementation of the SE48-TCM rationed fee-for-service (RFFS) model.

**Reason for Action:** As planned and discussed, SE48 - Targeted Case Management services is transitioning from an allotment payment with encounter reporting to a rationed fee-for-service (RFFS) claims process model effective Jan 1, 2013.

As part of this transition, the eXPRS technical team will end all current accepted SE48-TCM CPAs with an end date of 12/31/2012, and create new "draft" SE48 CPAs (which will relate to the RFFS claims process model) with a start date of 1/1/2013. Once these new CPAs are in "draft" status, the CDDPs must review them to ensure that all currently enrolled clients have respective SE48 CPAs; deleting any unneeded CPAs and/or creating new SE48/TCM CPAs, as needed.

The new "draft" SE48 CPAs are targeted to be ready for CDDP review and submission after the eXPRS release on 12/19/12.

Once reviewed, CDDPs can submit multiple "draft" SE48 CPAs as a batch, if they would prefer. Please see the HELP guide [How to Submit Multiple CPAs as a Batch](#) for assistance, if needed.
