Reason for action: Rates for Assisted Living Facilities, Residential Care Facilities, Memory Care Facilities, In-Home Care Agencies, and Nursing Facilities will increase effective July 1, 2015.

The new rates are shown on the Rate Schedule which can be accessed by clicking on the link listed below.

Action required: All system actions for providers paid through the MMIS system will be completed by Central Office staff and do not require any further actions by field staff.

A new Pay-In Calculation Worksheet will need to be printed for consumers that pay their cost of care and whose services are provided by an In-Home Care Agency. If the Pay-In has increased, the appropriate notice ([SDS 0540P – Notification of Increase in Service Payment](#)) must be sent with an effective date of 8/1/15, and the SFMU mainframe screen must be updated accordingly.

For consumers in facilities paid through the 512 system (ALF/RCF), no action will be required even if they pay the entire cost of care until a financial change occurs (deduction or income change) or a recertification.

The RCF/AFH rates listed on the Full Benefits Results screen in Oregon ACCESS will be updated when the AFH Collective Bargaining Agreement is ratified.
