**Action required:** Rates for Assisted Living Facilities, Residential Care Facilities, Memory Care Facilities, In-Home Care Agencies, and Nursing Facilities increased effective July 1, 2016. The new rates are shown on the Rate Schedule included with Policy Transmittal [APD-PT-16-022](#).

**Reason for action:** All system actions for providers paid through the MMIS system will be completed by Central Office staff and do not require any further actions by field staff.

- A new Pay-In Calculation Worksheet will need to be printed for consumers who pay their cost of care and whose services are provided by an In-Home Care Agency. If the Pay-In has increased, the appropriate notice [SDS 0540P – Notification of Increase in Service Payment](#) must be sent with an effective date of 8/1/16, and the SFMU mainframe screen must be updated accordingly.
- For Independent Choices Program consumers, due to the Live-In rate change, actions will be required for those with a Live-In provider. A separate transmittal will be issued with instructions on how to handle these in the near future.
- For Live-In service plans, there is a rate change for Live-In providers but no actions are required as there are no cost of care cases in the Live-In program. A

separate transmittal will be issued in the near future with additional information related to the Live-In rate changes.

- For consumers in nursing facilities with excessive maintenance income (EMI), case managers should print and send an updated 458AN for the consumer and an updated 458P for the facility. No system actions are required.
- For consumers in facilities paid through the 512 system (ALF/RCFAFH), no action will be required even if they pay the entire cost of care until a financial change occurs (deduction or income change) or a recertification.

The RCF rates listed on the Full Benefits Results screen in Oregon ACCESS will be updated.
