Increased CAPS Tier 2 Security Rights

- Users with the CAPS 2 Asmt Stat Admin Act security group will now have the ability to invalidate CAPS service benefits with begin dates in the past. More detailed information can be found in transmittal SPD-PT-10-046.

Narration Issues

- The narration will now print with the header and the page number (Page x of y) in all cases. In addition, the line of the narration at the bottom of the page will no longer be cut off. Previously, there were issues when the user was in read-only mode and printed the narration.
- The various problems that resulted from pasting information into the narration have been resolved. These include:
 - The color of the text changing to neon green or hot pink once the narration is saved.
 - Issues with templates including:
 - Loss of data
 - The font or background colors changing
 - Boxes appearing instead of blank spaces
- Previously saved narratives that displayed text as neon green or hot pink will now display as black text.
- The workaround for pasting text into a narration (utilizing Notepad), outlined in SPD-IM-10-085, is no longer necessary.
