This Information Memorandum is to inform you that the State Legislature has restored funding in this biennium for certain programs within the Department of Human Services that were previously slated for elimination or budget reductions. This restoration means that the planned actions will not take place this biennium. For developmental disability services, the funding restoration accomplished the following:

1. The 10% reduction in Targeted Case Management for Community Developmental Disability Programs and Support Service Brokerages planned for 4/1/11 will not occur.
2. The reduction in Targeted Case Management for children in Community Developmental Disability Programs planned for 4/1/11 will not occur.
3. The elimination of the Family Support Program (Service Element 150) planned for 4/1/11 will not occur. This program will continue through June 30, 2011.

The Targeted Case Management actions described in #1 and #2 above will not require any contract actions. However, the restoration of funding for the Family Support Program (#3 above) will require additional analysis and potential contract actions with Community Developmental Disability Programs. The Office of Developmental Disability Services has a goal of having this work completed and fully communicated by mid-March.
