Message: Recently, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) announced the 2011 Medicare Advantage and Medicare Advantage-Prescription Drug Plans (MA-PDs).

MA plans are offered by a private company that contracts with Medicare to provide beneficiaries with all their Medicare Part A and Part B benefits.

MA-PD plans are Medicare Advantage plans that offer Medicare Prescription Drug coverage along with Part A and Part B benefits in one plan. Medicare Advantage Plans are HMOs, PPOs, or Private Fee-for-Service Plans. When a client is enrolled in a Medicare Advantage Plan the Medicare services are paid through the plans, and are not paid through Original Medicare.
