**Message:**

Although the [2009-2011 Homecare Worker Collective Bargaining Agreement between SEIU, Local 503 and the Oregon Home Care Commission](#) has expired and has not been extended, homecare worker benefits remain in effect and local offices are required to follow current policies and procedures. This is commonly referred to as the “status quo period.” This applies to all articles of the agreement, with the exception of fair share deductions (no local office action required) and grievances. The Oregon Home Care Commission will continue to process grievances that were received on or before June 30, 2011.

Once the new collective bargaining agreement has been settled and ratified, SPD will issue further information about any changes.
