Request for Proposals #3675 for Home and Community Based Care Capacity Expansion Regions 2 and 5 opened on the Oregon Procurement Information Network (ORPIN). This Request for Proposal (RFP) process is to expand placement options for persons transitioning out of nursing facilities in the following counties: Malheur, Harney, Grant, Baker, Wallowa, Union, Umatilla, Morrow, Douglas, Lane, Linn, Benton, Lincoln, Marion, Polk, Yamhill, Tillamook, and Clatsop.

The proposal is requesting 30 “slots” or beds. The RFP will result in new Specific Needs contractors who will be able to provide community-based supports for person with complex behavioral or complex ADL needs. Final locations of these 30 beds will be based on which proposals are awarded.
