The Department of Human Services recently contracted with independent nurse contractors to provide Long-Term Care Community Nursing services under [OAR 411-048](#). Within this rule, under OAR 411-048-0220 it lists the reasons or ways either the Department or the Contractor could terminate their contractual relationship. OAR 411-048-0220(3) states: "Enrolled Medicaid providers of long term care community nursing services must provide advance written notice to the Department at least 30 days prior to no longer providing long term care community nursing services".

When the Department issues contracts to these Contractors, it failed to provide this as a clause within the contract.

The purpose of this information memorandum is to clarify the Department's stance. Any enrolled Contractor serving clients under this administrative rule has the right to terminate their contract with at least 30 days advanced written notice to the Department.
