**Message:** APD has been working to develop new systems coding which will allow case managers to create Service Only (OSV) cases for consumers whose underlying Medicaid eligibility is based on a Modified Adjusted Gross Income (MAGI) Medicaid program. At this time, APD will be delaying the implementation of these coding changes.

Due to unexpected issues, the work is taking longer than initially projected. Further, Central Office is aware that End of Year and Cost of Living Adjustment processing is the current priority.
