Message: APD has developed new coding which will allow case managers to create Service Only (OSV) cases for individuals whose underlying Medicaid eligibility is based on a Modified Adjusted Gross Income (MAGI) Medicaid program. This new coding will allow APD/AAA staff to administer the service portion of an individual's case, while OHA administers the medical portion.
