Effective immediately, clients in Children's Medical Eligibility Unit (CMEU or Branch 5517) who are within 6 months of turning 18 years of age can be transferred to the local APD/ AAA office **after** going through the redetermination process using **adult disability determination criteria**. New applicants that require a decision from the Presumptive Medicaid Disability Determination Team (PMDDT) will also be transferred to the local APD/AAA office during this time period **after** they have been approved by PMDDT. This approach will facilitate a smoother transition for these individuals by allowing extra time to ensure that they receive appropriate services.

Note: ***This does not apply to children in Children's In-Home Intensive Services (CIIS), Foster Care or Residential.***
