Discussion/Interpretation: Effective April 1, 2006, service rates for the following APD community facilities will increase as a result of a cost of living increase, approved by the Legislative Assembly:

- Assisted Living Facilities
- Residential Care Facilities - regular and contracted rates
- Commercial Adult Foster Homes
- Relative Adult Foster Homes
- Specialized Living Contracts
- Contract RN
- ElderPlace

Exceptional Payments:

Residential Care Facilities, Commercial Adult Foster Homes and Relative Adult Foster Homes will receive the cost of living increase based on the client's base rate plus add-ons.

Exceptional payments that exceed the base rate plus add-ons, will not receive the cost of living increase. Existing exception requests do not need to be re-submitted at this time, they should be submitted for review in the month they are expiring.

The new rates are shown on the attached rate schedule.

System Support for Rate Changes:

Central Office will run a job in the CBC/512 system to end all records that are in normal status (active not suspended) with an end date of 3/31/2006. A new record will be created with an effective date of 4/01/2006 that contains the new rates. We will not be updating any records that are in a suspend status. We will run the job on 3/30/2006. This is after the CMS monthly run so the CBC/512's will have the current client amounts. You will be able to view the new CBC records on-line and review the suspense reports on 3/31/2006. The 512's will start printing and being mailed on 03/31/2006 but due to the volume some may not be mailed until the first week of April.

This process is similar to the end of year job that we process annually. Please refer to IM-05-099 to clear up any suspend records you may have. If you have some records you are unable to clear up, you will have to start a new record by touching the 512 record with a start date of 4/01/2006.

In Oregon ACCESS the rate is saved when the CA/PS record is pushed to current so if you look at the current or historic record it will have a previous rate. If you look at a record that is pending or that is moved to current on or after 4/01/2006 it will reflect the new rate.

Note: Many of the contacts reflected on the CBC/512 record do not have adequate addresses. We have added some processing to detect these and suppress the printing.
