**SUBJECT:** Police Response

It has just come to my attention that some of the Marion County homes may not be responded to by the Oregon State Police when staff call 911. The homes in Keizer and Silverton will be dispatched first to the Keizer Police and Silverton Police respectively (see below). Keizer and Silverton Police (respectively) may make a decision to dispatch the call to their own officer on duty or they may refer it over to OSP.

The staff should still follow the previous memo & training which is to identify yourself as a SOCP home along with a detailed description of the incident & client. Staff should still offer the 4 digit OSP code but the Keizer & Silverton Police will make the decision as to who physically responds to the call. Silverton, Cade and Shoreline Staff should be told to expect either their local police or OSP. Clear as mud? Please e-mail with questions.
